

An autonomous institution of distinction and having the Hon'ble President of India as its Visitor, BHU is the largest residential University in Asia. Being a living embodiment of such visionaries as Mahamana Malaviya ji, Dr. Annie Besant and Dr. S. Radhakrishnan, this seat of learning epitomizes a synthesis of ancient wisdom and modern scientific temper. Its holistic model of education, conceived and enriched by its illustrious founder, offers refreshingly new perspectives to young minds and nurtures and facilitates their creative talents.


The Founder's Vision

The University

This University was conceived as a residential university, keeping in view its objective of complete character development and thorough mentoring of students. Perhaps this is the only university in the world where courses ranging from nursery and primary school up to Doctoral/ Post-doctoral degrees are taught and pursued within a walled campus spread over 550 Hectares (1360 acres) and having majestic buildings of great architectural delight.



It enshrines within its precincts, a phenomenal range of teaching disciplines incorporating almost all conceivable subjects of Science, Engineering & Technology, Medical Sciences, Humanities, Social Sciences, Commerce, Law, Education, Visual Arts, Performing Arts, Sanskrit Vidya Dharm Vigyan, Agriculture, Veterinary Sciences, Library Science, Journalism and a large number of Indian and Foreign Languages.

There are at present 5 departments receiving support under Special Assistance Programme, 7-UGC-Innovative / TRIEA / Other Programme and 3-DST-FIST (Fund for Improvement of Science & Technology) 4 departments/schools are supported under FIST programme of DST. It also has four colleges admitted to the privileges of the university which are located in the city. The university also has three schools apart from having a Kendriya Vidyalaya housed in the Campus.

In addition, the Rajiv Gandhi South Campus has been established in the year 2006 in a sprawling campus of 1092.6 Hectares (2700 acres) located about 75 kms away from the main campus, at Barkachha in Mirzapur district, Uttar Pradesh.

In NIRF, Banaras Hindu University has been consistently ranked among the top universities of India and it has also been recognized as an Institution of Eminence in the country by the Ministry of Education, a recognition given only to five Public Sector Universities of the nation.

Institute of Agricultural Sciences

Institute of Medical Sciences

The Institute of Medical Sciences comprises three faculties, namely, Faculty of Modern Medicine, Faculty of Ayurveda, and Faculty of Dental Sciences. It offers medical and paramedical courses at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. Through its hospitals, it caters to the clinical needs of more than 20 crores population hailing from 7 states (UP, Bihar, West Bengal, Jharkhand, Odisha, Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh) and neighbouring countries like Nepal and Bhutan. More than 40% of the patients visiting the hospital are from low economic strata.



At present, the hospitals have 2614 beds which includes 1385-Bed Sir Sunderlal Hospital; 180-Bed Ayurveda Wing; 334-Bed Trauma Centre; 13-Bed Dental Science; 430-Bed Centenary Super

Specialty Block; 100-Bed Mother & Child Health Wing; 60-Bed Centre of Excellence for Mental Health; 12-Bed Bone Marrow Transplant & Stem Cell Research Centre and 100 Bed Regional Institute of Ophthalmology.

Institute of Environmental and Sustainable Development

A National-level Institute of Environment & Sustainable Development was established in the year 2010. Recruitment of faculty was done in the year 2011. Using education as a tool to achieve sustainability, the institute aims to cover education for sustainable development. Mission of the Institute is to carry out teaching, research and extension relevant to India's sustainable development leading to the future that ends poverty and delivers and sustains efficient and equitable management of the country's natural resources.



Institute of Management Studies

The University started Post Graduate and doctoral program in Management in the year 1968 as a Department in the Faculty of Commerce. Envisaging the increasing need for imparting quality management education and research, the University transformed the Department of Management Studies to an independent Faculty of Management Studies in the year 1984. Dedicated efforts were made to run innovative and need based programs for the corporate world under the dynamic leadership of professors of national and international repute. The Faculty has been upgraded to Institute of Management Studies in December 2015.



Institute of Science

Established in 1916, the Faculty of Science which later on upgraded to Institute of Science as a constituent institute of the University, offers under graduate and post graduate courses besides offering Ph.D. program and several diploma and certificate courses. The Institute comprises of 13 Departments, 6 Centres and 2 Interdisciplinary Schools. Equipped with advanced and sophisticated laboratories and research facilities the institute is marching ahead towards excellence in teaching, learning and research in almost all domains of basic and applied sciences.




Largest Residential Campus in Asia

Over 35,000 students from all over India and abroad are enrolled in various faculties of the university. The university has more than 72 hostels, having nearly 11000 inmates, with all modern amenities including internet for the students. It also has a specially designed International Student hostel to accommodate large number of foreign students who study here. It also has 1590 staff quarters and 7 guest houses on the campus.

Library

BHU has a Central Library system having more than 15 lacs volumes apart from subscription to more than 15000 online journals, 50000 e-books, databases and a huge collection of digitalized rare manuscripts. It functions in conjunction with a chain of Departmental, Faculty and Institute libraries. In addition, BHU has a fully air-conditioned Cyber Library with a seating capacity of over 200. Newly created air-conditioned Periodical Hall provides 60 cabins for the use of faculty members and research scholars.




ICT Infrastructure

The University (Varanasi & RGSC both) has Wi-Fi enabled campus. All the academic and administrative offices are Wi-Fi connected. In addition, the University has 240 kilometres long fibre optic backbone of campus wide LAN, connecting all academic and administrative buildings as well as hostels with a well-equipped Computer Centre, providing high end computing and training facilities. The university has been provided three 1 Gbps nodes of National Knowledge Network (NKN) under NME-ICT. Besides these, more than 100 smart classrooms have been augmented for smoothening the online teaching and learning especially during the COVID times. The university has switched over to computer based entrance test and implemented ERP for executing all administrative and financial work, thereby moving towards paperless office.

The Temple

The Banaras Hindu University has a temple of Lord Shiva called Shri Vishwanath Temple. It is situated at the centre of the campus. The temple is built with white marble. Its detailed planning was done by Malaviyaji himself. The lush campus of Shri Vishwanath Temple and the beautiful gardens surrounding it area delight to the eyes of the visitors. The interior of the temple has a Shiva Lingam, and verses from Hindu scriptures are inscribed on the walls of the temple with pictorial depiction.




Bharat Kala Bhavan

BHU has a museum of international importance - Bharat Kala Bhawan, which is a treasure trove of rare art and artefacts. The Bharat Kala Bhavan has 13 galleries having a collection of more than 1 lakh antique and rare sculptures, miniature paintings, Rajasthani, Mughal and Pahari paintings, coins, jewelry, precious stones, etc. of immense historic value and a very special literary gallery containing manuscripts of famous authors. It also has a rich library containing rare books.



Rajiv Gandhi South Campus

The Banaras Hindu University has extended its outreach by establishing its South Campus at Barkachha in Mirzapur district. The RGSC is being developed as a potential hub of education, training and entrepreneurship for youth and women, especially those belonging to tribes and weaker sections of the society. The campus is being developed by the University with a mission to enrich the lives of the population of the region by extending to them opportunities to engage in life-long learning and to benefit from the result of research.



Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences

Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences was established in the year 2015 with an inception of the idea to have a surge of elite veterinary experts from the world repute central university, Banaras Hindu University. With the mission approach Veterinary faculty came into existence and started its functioning under Institute of Agricultural Sciences. The Faculty comprises of 15 departments and 2 units (Livestock farm Complex and Teaching Veterinary Clinical Complex) and it is spread in an area of 126 acres. Presently faculty is having core strength of around 60 faculty member's expertise in different horizon of veterinary profession. All the departments are well versed with modern facilities of teaching and research.



POST GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS IN VETERINARY SCIENCE

MASTER OF VETERINARY SCIENCE (M.V.Sc.) PROGRAM

The Master of Veterinary Science (M.V.Sc.) program will be of two-year duration, covering four semesters offered by different departments at the Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, I.Ag.Scs., RGSC, Barkachha.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1. A candidate should possess a basic Undergraduate degree *i.e.* B.V.Sc. & A.H. with a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate or an OGPA of 6 out of 10 on a 10-point scale and 55% in aggregate or an OGPA of 5.5 out of 10 for SC/ST candidates (refer to table below) from a recognized veterinary college.

2. The candidate should possess the B.V.Sc & A.H. degree on or before the last date of submission of the application form.
3. Candidate selected for admission through AIEEA (PG)-2025 (conducted by NTA for ICAR) may seek admission only during the session for which the examination has been conducted. He/she will not be entitled for admission in subsequent sessions based on this year's examination and thus cannot claim for seat allotment in other sessions/years based on this examination.

RESERVATIONS AND RELAXATIONS:

Reservation roster of the Government of India (General, OBC, SC, ST, EWS, PwD) shall be applicable for M.V.Sc course for each Department/Discipline.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. **Mode of Selection:** Admission of candidates shall be based on the rank obtained in ICAR-AIEEA (PG) 2025 examination against their respective subject group (Table-1) conducted by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), followed by counselling by the University.
During counseling, candidates must opt for their preferred subject based on seat availability and the reservation policy of the University.
2. **Merit List Preparation:** A merit list will be prepared for all candidates applying for admission based on their overall rank obtained in ICAR-AIEEA (PG) 2025 examination against their respective subject group.
3. The shortlisted candidates will be allowed to opt for their choice of seat during the time of counseling for their preferred subject, based on seat availability and the reservation policy of the university, and a payment link will be provided.

NOTE

1. All the above fees (Semester-I) should be paid at the time of admission.

BHU Admission Fee Refund Policy:

1. **Full Refunds:** Candidate will receive a full refund of the admission fee if the candidate withdraws his/her admission before the last date of admission set by BHU.
2. For cancellations made within 30 days after the closer of the admission, refund will be made after deduction of Rs. 1000 as processing fee. Beyond this date no refund will be permissible
3. **Refund Processing Timeline:** Once admissions are closed, BHU will initiate the refund process. They aim to settle all refunds within three months of closing admissions. We recommend that the candidate carefully review the refund policy before applying. This will help candidate to understand which fees are refundable and the timeframe for receiving a refund if candidate withdraw his/her application.

NOTE: *Caution money and security deposits, which are not part of the fees chargeable, shall be refunded in full.

HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

Separate Hostel for Boys and Girls are available only for regular seats. At present hostel accommodation is limited to girl /boys student based on availability. Candidates are not entitled for hostel accommodation under paid seat category; however they may be considered depending upon the availability of accommodation following University rules.

Hostel Annual fee: 1st year, Rs.: 7500/- and Second Year onwards Rs.: 5500/-

Note: If a student discontinues the course completely, only the hostel caution deposit and mess deposit will be refunded, after adjustment, if any.

General Notes:

The candidate shall be bound by BHU Statutes/Ordinances/Rules and Regulations framed from time to time.

General Rules:

- (i) A candidate who satisfies the requirements mentioned in bulletin should apply on the prescribed online Application Form for admission in degree program offered.
- (ii) Application Forms of candidates who have submitted forged/fake certificates or adopted fraudulent means shall be REJECTED.
- (iii) Candidates shall be admitted to the M.V.Sc program subject to the final verification of Mark sheets/Degrees/Certificates, validity of Certificates/Mark sheets of Qualifying Examination at the time of admission. Degrees/Certificates recognized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) shall only be deemed as equivalent degrees/certificates.
- (iv) Mere appearance or securing qualifying marks in the B.V.Sc & AH course or qualifying examination **does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission to a discipline unless he/she fulfills the eligibility conditions.**

APPLICANTS MUST FULLY SATISFY THEMSELVES ABOUT THEIR ELIGIBILITY AS PRESCRIBED ABOVE BEFORE FILLING IN THE APPLICATION FORM.

FILLING IN THE APPLICATION FORM.

The University has created its Admission portal with the domain name <https://admission.bhu.ac.in/en>. The **M.V.Sc. Information Bulletin 2025-26** is available on **BHU admission portal**. The entire process of counselling for **M.V.Sc.** 2025 application for admission in various disciplines during the academic session 2025-26 shall be made ONLINE. Accordingly, candidates may note that **M.V.Sc.** Information Bulletin 2025 and Application Form will not be sold in Physical Mode and the candidates desirous of admissions are required to register on the Admission portal of BHU and fill up the application form ONLINE as per procedure provided on the Portal. For further details visit the website <https://bhuadm.samarth.edu.in/index.php>.

Instructions for Submission of Application Form:

Applicants must fully satisfy themselves about their eligibility before filling the application

Online Application Form:

The Application Form for M.V.Sc is available on the BHU's Admission portal <https://admission.bhu.ac.in/en>. The online application making process will have following steps:

Step 1: Registration on the Portal

This step involves authentication of Candidate's email id and mobile number. Candidates are required to have a valid email id and mobile No. (in use) for registration.

Step 2: Filling up Identification details-Only after successful registration on the Portal [<https://bhuadm.samarth.edu.in/index.php>], the candidates would be required to fill up an Identification Form giving particulars of the documents for authentication of their identity. For this purpose, following photo identification documents are allowed: (i) Aadhaar Card; (ii) Passport; (iii) Voter ID issued by the Election Commission of India; (iv) Bank Passbook affixed with the photograph (v) Driving License; and (vi) Pan Card; (vii) any other valid Government ID Number.

Step 3: Online Application Form Entry- After successful authentication of identity, candidates would be allowed to fill-up details in the online application form after ensuring their eligibility in the course.

Step 4: Uploading of photographs and signature- Candidates have to scan their photo and signature as per instruction given in the portal and upload it. **Rank of ICAR-AIEEA (PG) 2025 along with its Score Card must be carefully entered and uploaded.**

Step 5: Payment of Application Processing/ Registration Fee- After the candidate has filled up the application form online and clicks on the "SUBMIT" button, he/she will be made payment of application processing fee through online payment credit card/debit card through the payment gateway available on the portal.

Step 6: Printout of Application Form for the record of candidates- After online submission of application form and successful payment of Application Processing Fee (Non-refundable), candidates are advised to take a printout of the online filled up application form (containing the details he/she has filled in and the transaction details of payment of application fee) for their own record.

Reasons for Rejection of the Application Forms:

- (i) Submission of application form without payment of requisite amount of Application Processing
- (ii) Any other inadequacy detected.

NOTE: If at any stage it is found that the applicant is not eligible for admission in a discipline under University rules, his/her candidature will automatically stand cancelled. Please note that thorough checking of Application Form, Minimum Eligibility requirements, Original documents in support of Academic Certificates and Categories-claimed will be done only at the time of admission. At that stage also, the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled, if he/she does not fulfill all the requirements for admission.

- (i) The Application Form once submitted with the Application Processing Fee at concessional rate meant for SC/ST candidate shall be considered under SC/ST Category.
- (ii) The Application Processing Fee paid shall neither be refunded nor transferred to another course and shall also not be reserved for any subsequent year, in any case.
